

## **Business Services**

While largely mirroring the S&P 500, the business services market has been strong from an M&A and valuation perspective. Industry valuations are holding steady despite recent volatility in the public markets. Entering 2018, the business services industry is poised for another year of mid single-digit growth, as some industry leaders transition to a value-oriented revenue model with modularized service offerings and fully automated back-end services.





## **S&P 500 Professional Services Index**





## **S&P North America BMI Commercial & Professional Services Index**




